


THANKS TO REV. FR. PANDARAKAPPIL ALEX AND REV. FR. NEELANKAVIL DEVAMITRA


INAUGURATION OF VILLAGE APOSTOLATE

LATE BISHOP MAR. ABRAHAM D. MATTAM: DAY OF COMMEMORATION



16th July, the 92nd day of the demise of the first Bishop of the diocese of Satna Mar Abraham D. Mattam was solemnly commemorated in St. Ephrem's Theological College. The memorial Qurbana was celebrated by Mar. Joseph Kodakallil, Msgr. Fr. John Thoppil, Fr. Mathew Vattakuzhy VC, Fr. Ottapurackal Joseph and Fr. Manu CMF and several priests of Satna diocese, Ephrem Pariwar, sisters from different congregations, lay men from different parishes of the diocese also participated in the memorial Qurbana.

Memorial meeting was held soon after the holy Qurbana. The community remained in silence for a while in memory of late Bp. Mattam. Fr. Ottapurackal Joseph welcomed all to the memorial meeting. Bp. Kodakallil

delivered the presidential address and he recollected his old memories with him. Rev. Fr. Mathew Vattakuzhy VC who served as the Secretary of Satna Eparchy in the initial stages pondered over his experiences with Bp. Mattam and spoke about the hardships in the initial stages of the Eparchy and how Bp. Mattam beat all the difficulties in starting an eparchy. Rev. Sr. Rose Therese SABS pooled her experience with Bp. Mattam during the starting of her congregation in the Eparchy and thanked Bp. Mattam for the support and care given to the SABS congregation. Rev. Fr. Job Vallianal shared his memory as a Chancellor and General Manager of schools during the period of Bp. Mattam and recollected the encouragement, support and motivation given by Bp. Mattam during his service to St. Ephrem's. Mrs. Hanna Khonsla a member of the Cathedral church of the Eparchy recollected her childhood memories, the interaction of the Bishop with parishioners, love and affection showed to them. Mr. Stephen from Kailaspur united his memories of Bishop, as a zealous missionary who worked very hard in the forming of Christian village of Kailaspur. Rev. Sr. Vijaya DST imparted her memories of beginning the DST houses in the Eparchy with the help of Bp. Mattam. She recollected the support and encouragement given by Bishop. Mr. Joy shared his memories, the interest, love and care showed by Bp. Mattam for the Ecumenical activities in the diocese of Satna. Memorial meeting was concluded with the words of gratitude by Rev. Fr. Thoppil John, Vicar General of the Eparchy. Thereafter all the guests were nourished with delicious meal.
