YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH

In collaboration with the Eparchy of Satna, ETC celebrated the Year of St. Joseph on 1st March 2021. The programme began with a novena of St. Joseph by His Excellency Mar Joseph Kodakallil who later inaugurated an extension lecture. It was a memorable and enriching exposition led by Rev. Fr. Sebastian Poonolil VC on 'Patris Corde: Spectrum of St. Joseph.' An International Eucharistic miracles' Exhibition catalogued by Blessed Carlo Acutis was displayed in 153 panel in ETC old auditorium. These panels express the details of the Eucharistic miracles approved by the Ecclesiastical authority. Panels were arranged according to the countries and the period of occurrence. Followed by the exhibition there were cultural events. Candidates and Brothers performed their talents. There were 2 dances and a song accompanied by a lively drawing of the Holy Family.
